Parent Council Communications (ongoing)

Inclusion in newsletter, ad hoc use of Facebook to share useful/interesting information, ensuring meetings advertised in advance and all parents invited, agenda and minutes issued. Unable to do face to face introductions to new parents again, parent council info sent with induction paperwork instead.

Garden

Unable to progress due to restrictions on parents entering school grounds. Funding obtained through grant applications (see below) should ensure the children can fully utilise this space for outdoor learning and hope that parents can return to help maintain and develop this area soon. The children have been busy doing this in the meantime.

Funding received from successful grant applications:

Onefamily (£2,500) – funds provided for a shelter following the fire and removal of the shelter shed, plan to purchase shade sail and fireproof store plus other items to support outdoor learning and play (to be discussed with new HT)

Tesco (£997) – store and outdoor equipment purchased to replace items lost in the shelter shed fire

Thrift Shop (£500) – funds kindly donated to enable school to plug gaps in the Big Cat reading series
